

# Oklahoma Central Website Privacy Notice

## Tips to Help Protect Your Nonpublic Personal Information

- Before revealing nonpublic personal information to third parties, find out how it will be used and if others will share it.
- Keep documents with nonpublic personal information in a secure place. Either tear or shred them when disposing. Dispose of check copies, statements, charge receipts, insurance forms, expired check cards and credit offers the same way.
- You can also help maintain the security of your nonpublic personal information by not sharing your user ID, PIN or password with anyone, by changing your password regularly and by remembering to sign off if using a personal computer.
- Remove your name from direct mailing and e-mail lists by registering at the Direct Marketing Association's Consumer Information site at [www.dmchoice.org](http://www.dmchoice.org).
- You can also stop telemarketing calls by registering online at the Federal Trade Commission's "Do Not Call Registry" at [www.donotcall.gov](http://www.donotcall.gov) or calling toll-free (888) 382-1222 from the telephone number you wish to register. Registration is free.

## Our Online Privacy Practices

Keeping financial and personal information secure is one of our most important responsibilities. We value your trust and handle personal information with care and Oklahoma Central Credit Union is committed to protecting the information of members and visitors who use our website.

As with information we collect through other means, we use the information you provide online to respond to your needs, service your accounts, and provide you information about other services.

## Secure Transmissions

To ensure information remains confidential, Oklahoma Central Credit Union uses encryption technology such as Secure Socket Layer (SSL) to protect information you enter and submit from our website.

## Email Security

Regular Internet email is not secure. You should never provide information that is sensitive or confidential. We ask that you do not send personal or account information through regular email. Oklahoma Central Credit Union provides a method of sending a secure email to the credit union through online banking under the "Additional services" tab or you can call us at 918-664-6000 or 1-800-444-6228.

## Children's Online Privacy

This web site is not intended for use by anyone under 13 years of age, except for the direct link to Banzai. This link is provided as a convenience only, not as a link to attract minors under 13 years of age to go beyond or use any page other than the Banzai information page. If information is provided to open a minor account, it must be provided by the parents of the minor and requires a signature of the parent.

## Cookies

A cookie is a small piece of information that a website stores directly on the computer you are using. Cookies can contain a variety of information, from a simple count of how often you visit a website to information which allows customization of a website for your use. Oklahoma Central Credit Union uses cookies to gather data about the usage of our website and to ensure that you have access to your account information. Anytime a cookie is used, personal information is encrypted for our use only and is protected from third party access (a cookie cannot be read by a website other than the one that sets the cookie).

To provide you with greater access of information, we may provide links to non-Oklahoma Central Credit Union companies, such as mortgage companies or insurance companies. Oklahoma Central Credit Union is not responsible for the content of the alternate website and cannot guarantee the relevance, timeliness, or accuracy of the materials provided by other agencies or organizations. Oklahoma Central Credit Union does not represent either the third party or the member if the two enter into a transaction.
